


SUBJECT: Change in Carburetor Inlet Seats

Clinton Carburetor Inlet Seats have been changed from "6 thread" inlet seats to "3 thread" inlet seats. Carburetor bodies were also changed. The present seals will not fit in the newest carburetor bodies. The "6 thread" and "3 thread" seats are illustrated below.

NEW "3 THREAD" SEAT

Your present stock of parts can be used for repairing most carburetors. An "R" has been added to the part number to indicate the new or revised inlet seat. For example, 14211 would indicate the standard "6 thread" seat. Number 14211-R would indicate the new seat "3 thread" which will be needed in many cases this season to service the present carburetor. The "3 thread" seat assembly must be used on carburetors which have only 3 tapped threads. The new parts will eventually deplete out the present needle and seat assembly. Part numbers involved are as follows:

OTE: The new P-14559-A-R seat is interchangeable with the old P-14559-A and 14391-A seats.
